2018 Vocational/Career and Technical Education Students

Applicant must be pursuing formal vocational/career and technical training that will result in a recognized certificate or diploma.

Please review the attached document *Scholarship Awards Descriptions and Requirements – 2018 Continuing Education and Vocational/Career and Technical Education Students* for specifics on each category of scholarships.

The KEA Scholarship Selection Committee will evaluate all complete application packets based on scholastic achievement, character, leadership, community involvement, educational goals, and potential future contributions to the cooperative and/or the community. The weight to be allotted to each of the criteria and special circumstances given shall be determined by the KEA Scholarship Selection Committee. Additional weighting through the evaluation process may be given to first time applicants. Interviews with applicants may be requested. Applications and documents will not be returned unless you include this request on your application.

Upon award notification, applicants selected to receive KEA Scholarship Awards will be requested to provide a digital photograph that may be used for public relations and

marketing material. Excerpts from recipients' acceptance letters or letters of appreciation may also be used for public relations or marketing materials.

To be considered for these scholarships, a complete application packet must be submitted! An eligibility checklist for your use is included with this application.

Special Reminders: Official transcripts including your most recently completed quarter or semester grades must be submitted in an envelope provided and sealed by your school Registrar's Office or Transcript Service; unofficial transcripts, faxed transcripts, and internet printed grades will not be accepted. School Registrar transcript processing time varies; please allow your school time to handle your request. Note to University of Alaska students: Kodiak College, UAA, UAF, and UAS students may obtain expedited transcripts from the Registrar's Office at Kodiak College. Include two current letters of recommendation, signed and dated no earlier than December 1, 2016. Undated letters and letters signed and dated before December 1, 2016 will be disqualified, and the entire scholarship application will be fully disqualified from consideration. At least one letter must be from a reference not employed by the Kodiak Island Borough School District.

All complete application documents must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on February 16, 2018 at the KEA office at 1614 Mill Bay Road, Kodiak, Alaska, 99615. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
