Applicant must be a graduating senior from Kodiak High School, Port Lions High School, a Kodiak Island Borough School District Program, or a correspondence study or distance delivery program accredited by the State of Alaska Department of Education, and must have a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.0. Applicant must be receiving service from Kodiak Electric Association.

*One (1) \$7,000 Academic Scholarship

These are one-time scholarship awards.
